### New Branding

Wipes cause blockages which not only can cause issues further up the line in your bathrooms, and overflows into the environment, they are also expensive to fix which means less funds for other improvements in the Community.

This is a reminder from Hunter Water to only ever flush the Three P's – pee, poo and (toilet) paper. NO WIPES of any kind please!

## Recipe of the Month Chicken meatballs with couscous

# 45m prep 25m cook 4 servings Ingredients:

1 red onion, finely chopped

2 cloves garlic, crushed

500g chicken mince

1 egg, lightly beaten

1 cup dried breadcrumbs

1/2 cup flat-leaf parsley, chopped

1 tbsp extra virgin olive oil

1/4 cup mild korma curry paste (store bought)

2 x 400g cans diced tomatoes

1/2 cup natural yoghurt

Couscous, cooked, to serve



#### **Method:**

Step 1


Combine onion, garlic, mince, egg, breadcrumbs and half the parsley in a bowl. Season. Roll into balls. Cover. Chill for 30 minutes.
